PhD - Eco-immunology of red squirrels

We are interested in examining the immunological consequences of testosterone using manipulative experiments in our study site (Algonquin Park, Ontario)

MSc – Causes and consequences of zoonotic bacteria infection in rodent hosts

We have detected a zoonotic bacteria (*Coxiella burnetii*) in a number of rodent species in Algonquin Park.

MSc/PhD – Genetic and fitness consequences of introgression of domestic mink into wild mink populations.

In collaboration with Dr. Jeff Bowman, Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources, we have been examining aspects of hybridization between wild and domestic mink
